

Graduate Student Travel Award

2023-2024 Points System

GSA Travel Award Applications will be evaluated according to the priority system noted online and then by totaling the following points scale. **Based on available funding, applicants could receive funding up to the amounts listed unless actual receipts are less.**

Please note that the Graduate School will review applications for good standing GPA and provide only those applications that meet the 3.0 GPA to the Graduate Student Association for further review.

- 1-3 points up to \$200
- 4 points up to \$300
- 5 points up to \$400
- 5+ points up to \$500

Type of event

- 2 points for attending a conference or annual meeting taking place outside the United States
- 1.5 points for attending a conference or annual meeting taking place outside the state of North Carolina
- 1 point for attending a conference or annual meeting taking place within the state of North Carolina
- 1 point for competitions
- 0.5 points for attending other events such as seminars, workshops, museum tours, etc.

Activity at Event

- 3.5 points for an oral or poster presentation
- 2 points for accepting an award
- 1.5 points for competing in an academic competition
- 1 point for participating in a seminar, workshop, training program, or other professional development activity

In the event that GSA has more eligible students than funding, GSA will continue to assign points based on the items below.

Presented at the 3 Minute Thesis Competition

- 0.5 point if yes
- 0 points if no

Presented at the Graduate Research Symposium

- 0.5 point per presentation
- 0 points if no
